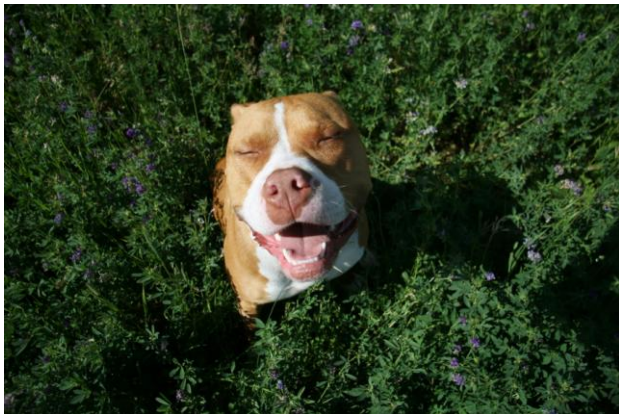

Together we can rescue those who need us most and bring Pit Bulls back into our communities as a respectable breed.



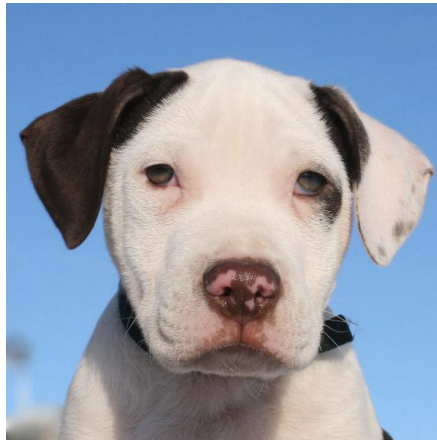

FOSTERING

Our foster homes are the most important aspect of our rescue because they are the ones that spend countless hours rehabilitating and loving their foster dog, making him or her more adoptable.

If you are interested in being a foster home, we require that you fill out a foster questionnaire as well as allow us to do a home check to ensure that we are placing our dogs in a secure and safe environment.

As a foster home you are supplied with a kennel, collar and leash, veterinarian care, and obedience support.



VOLUNTEERING

Our volunteers are very important in running and maintaining our rescue foundation. We are always in need of volunteers that can transport dogs or supplies, perform home checks for potential foster homes and potential adoption homes as well as fundraising events and manning booths at trade shows events around Alberta.

ADOPTING



Adopting any dog is very rewarding. It is not only saving a life but it is finding that loving family member. Adopting a Pit Bull is standing up for the right to own a strong, loving, obedient breed and fighting for the right for this wonderful breed to live on.

Our adoption protocol is very stringent; designed to be a lengthy process to ensure that all new dogs placed in the home are going to be in the same home for their lifetime. The potential adopter must be at least 18 years of age. The process starts by filling out an adoption questionnaire via our website.

The Pit Bulls for Life Foundation's adoption fee is \$300. This includes: Spaying or neutering, Vaccinations including rabies and Microchip identification

Pit Bulls for Life will not ship any dog to a potential home. If you live outside of the area that the foster dog lives all family members of a potential adoption must come to the foster home to visit the dog that they are interested in. Our foster homes are located all over the province of Alberta.
